

ORDINANCE NO. 52

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE VILLAGE BOUNDARIES

The Village Council of the Village of Foley do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the village boundaries of the Village of Foley are hereby extended so as to include the following described land, located in Auditor's Subdivision of a part of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-nine (29), Benton County, Minnesota, abutting upon said village and of record in the names of Alvin D. Hamer and Alma T. Hamer, his wife, to-wit:

The West Half (W $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Lot Three (3);

and of record in the names of James Edward O'Neil and Frances O'Neil, his wife, to-wit:

Lot Four (4);

and of record in the names of Lee McKenzie and Gladys McKenzie, his wife, to-wit:

The East Fifty feet of Lot Five (E 50 ft. of Lot 5)  
and the East Fifty feet of the North Half of Lot Six  
(E 50 ft. of N $\frac{1}{2}$  of Lot 6).
