State of Minnesota on the 10th day of April, 1912, to vote
on the question of whether said village of Federal Dam should
become a separate election and a separate assessment district
from the organized township of Gould, Minnesota, and unorganized
Congressional township of One Hundred Forty four north (144 N.)
of Range Twenty eight West (28) of the fifth principal meridian,
the said townships being the townships in which said incorporated
village of Federal Dam, Minnesota, lies.

said proposition, as canvassed by us, to wit:
