EXECUTIVE INFORMATION  
A Recognition of Good Service Day

WHEREAS, a strong recognition Good Service is vital if America is to do the full part in maintaining the peace and our Navy, accordingly, has created a civilian Naval Reserve to train sufficient young officers to ensure this strength, and this program is of tremendous value to our Country and to our State in preparing our young citizens for the responsibilities of future life; and

- WHEREAS, the Navy and Naval Reserve are endeavoring to enroll into the Reserve additional young people to carry these standards on; and the full participation of Ohio State is necessary to the success of this national endeavor; and,
- WHEREAS, the Presidents of the United States has been set to appoint specific dates for national recognition and observance of the CIVILIAN NAVY.

WHEREAS, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDAHL, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby designate and proclaim that the period from May 15th to May 19th, 1937, inclusive, be observed and observed throughout this State as Good Service Day, and the safety of our men as Good Service Day.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul this twenty-ninth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred forty-seven and of the State the one hundred.
