

EXECUTIVE MESSAGE

A Declaration of Human Investment Needs

WHEREAS, more student nurses are needed to provide graduate nurses for vital jobs in our hospitals, clinics and other health facilities; and

WHEREAS, the growing interest in health and demands for hospital care are bringing expansion of hospitals and other health facilities which indicate the need for nurses will become even greater in years to come; and

WHEREAS, information on the opportunities and advantages of a nursing education and nursing career must be brought to the attention of the young women in our state so that they may properly weigh the future of the nursing profession against that offered by other professions for women; and

WHEREAS, the efforts of Minnesota's hospitals, nurses, doctors and other groups to interest young women in nursing as a profession deserve the cooperation of the entire state,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WALTER W. YOUNGDALE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June 3 through June 10, 1947, as

"NURSING HUMAN INVESTMENT WEEK"
