

ORDINANCE No. 68.

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF LAMBERTON, REDWOOD COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

Be it ordained by the Village Council of Lamberton, as follows: WHEREAS, a petition signed by more than five of the legal voters residing within the territory hereinafter described, petitioning the Village Council of the Village of Lamberton to annex the territory hereinafter described, and it has been determined that said territory contains a population of more than 75 persons and that no part of said territory is included in any incorporated city or village but adjoins the Village of Lamberton, and no part of which territory is more than one-half mile from the present limits of the Village of Lamberton, and an election has been duly held by the resident legal voters of said territory and at which election more than the majority of the legal voters of said territory voting at said election voted in favor of annexing said territory to the Village of Lamberton.

NOW, THEREFORE, It is hereby ordained that the premises lying and being in the County of Redwood and State of Minnesota and described as follows, be and hereby are annexed to the Village of Lamberton, and the same hereby are declared to be an Addition to said Village of Lamberton and a part of said Village as effectually as if it had been originally a part thereof, to-wit:

All of Blocks One (1) to Eleven (11) inclusive, of M. L. McGee's Addition to the Village of Lamberton, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said County and State, including all streets and alleys, the streets in said Addition having been dedicated to public use but the alleys thereof having been dedicated to the owners of the lands abutting said alleys, said Addition being part of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of Section Twenty-two (22), Township One Hundred Nine (109) North, of Range Thirty-seven (37) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Redwood County, Minnesota.

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a meeting of the Common Council of the Village of Lambertton, Redwood County, Minnesota, was duly held in the Village Council Room in the community hall in the Village of Lambertton, Minnesota, on the 7th day of Nov., 1946, at 8 o'clock, P. M. The following members were present: P. W. K. Luegel, R. W. Olson, R. G. Johnson, A. E. Oursdahl, Chris Rongstad

Councilman R. W. Olson introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

A Resolution for Annexing Territory
to the Village.

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Common Council of the Village of Lambertton, Redwood County, Minnesota:

1. WHEREAS, a petition has been filed by five or more legal voters of the territory hereinafter described, certifying under oath that there are more than 75 actual residents on the lands embraced in said territory, and that a true and correct canvass of said residents of said territory was taken within four weeks of the date of said petition, and which territory adjoins the Village limits of the Village of Lambertton, and no part of which territory is more than one-half mile from the present limits of the Village of Lambertton, and praying said territory hereinafter described be annexed and added to the Village of Lambertton.

5. The following residents of said territory are appointed as judges for said election, to-wit: Bert Blatcher and Mrs. Clarence Rongetad and Mrs. Esther Johnson.

6. Said election shall in all respects be held and conducted and returns thereof made and canvassed in the manner prescribed by law for elections in townships.

7. Upon the receipt by the Clerk of a certificate verified and signed by all of said judges stating the time and place of holding said election and that they have canvassed ballots cast thereat and showing the number cast for and against said proposition, and if said certificate shows the majority of votes cast at said election were in the affirmative, then the Clerk hereby is directed to attach said certificate to the original petition with a copy of this resolution and the original Proof of Posting of the election notices and file the whole thereof as one document in his office, and he shall then and in that event forthwith make and transmit to the Secretary of the State of Minnesota a certified copy of said document to be filed as a public record, and shall also transmit to the County Auditor of Redwood County, Minnesota, a certified copy of said document, and thereupon the annexation of said territory to the Village of Lambertton shall be deemed in all respects complete.
