



PETITION

TO BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MCLEOD COUNTY STATE OF MINNESOTA

The undersigned voters residing in and who have resided continuously for a period of at least two years within the territory hereinafter described to be incorporated as a village, hereby respectfully petition you to appoint a time and place, when and where, the voters residing within said territory, so to be incorporated, may vote for or against such incorporation.

The territory proposed to be incorporated as a village is wholly within the County of McLeod, State of Minnesota, and the boundaries of which are set forth and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the east line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 26 T116R29 being 898.5 feet north of the southeast corner thereof; thence west at an angle of 90° a distance of 285 feet; thence south parallel to the east line of said section 26 to a point in the southeast quarter of said section 26 being 181.5 feet south and 285 feet west of the northeast corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 26; thence west to a point 181.5 feet south and 640 $\frac{5}{6}$ feet west of the northeast corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 26; thence south parallel to the east line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 26, 644.5 feet; thence east 640 $\frac{5}{6}$ feet to the east line of section 26, which point is 826 feet south of the northeast corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 26; thence easterly to a point 92.5 feet southeasterly of the southwest corner of Novak's addition to Biscay according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for McLeod County, Minnesota, as measured along the westerly line of Novak's addition as extended southeasterly; thence northeasterly 432.0 feet to a point 356.5 feet southeasterly of the southeast corner of Kennedy's 2nd addition to Biscay; thence northwesterly 356.5 feet to the southeast corner of Kennedy's 2nd addition to Biscay according to the plat thereof on file

and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for McLeod County, Minnesota, thence northwesterly along the northeasterly line of said Kennedy's 2nd addition to Biscay 1254 feet to the northeasterly corner thereof; thence southwesterly 182.5 feet to the southeasterly corner of block 7, Kennedy's 1st addition to Biscay according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for McLeod County, Minnesota; thence northwesterly along the north line of said block 7, 198 feet to a point 33 ft. east of the west line of the NW¹/₄ of section 25; thence north to a point 33 feet east of the place of beginning; thence west to the place of beginning.

WHEREAS, on October 21, 1946, a petition, signed by Ervin Fabricio, Lloyd T. Hammerstrom, Fred J. Burdick, and others, was filed in the Office of the County Auditor of Beland County, Minnesota, wherein the petitioners requested the Board of Commissioners of Beland County, Minnesota, to call an election for the determination of the proposed incorporation as a village of the following described real estate situated in Beland County, Minnesota, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the East line of the Northeast quarter of Section 26, Township 116, Range 29, being 892.5 feet North of the Southeast corner thereof; thence West at an angle of 95 degrees a distance of 225 feet; thence South parallel to the East line of said Section 26 to a point on the Southeast corner of said Section 26 being 181.5 feet South and 205 feet West of the Northeast corner of the Southeast quarter of said Section 26; thence West to a point 181.5 feet South and 640 $\frac{5}{8}$ th feet West of the Northeast corner of the Southeast quarter of said Section 26; thence South parallel to the East line of the Southeast quarter of said Section 26, 604.5 feet; thence East 640 $\frac{5}{8}$ th feet to the East line of Section 26, which point is 226 feet South of the Northeast corner of the Southeast quarter of Section 26; thence easterly to a point 92.5 feet southeasterly of the Southwest corner of Novak's Addition to Biscay, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of the Register of Deeds, Beland County, Minnesota, as measured along the westerly line of Novak's Addition as extended southeasterly; thence northeasterly 432 feet to a point 356.5 feet southeasterly of the Southeast corner of Kennedy's 2nd Addition to Biscay; thence northeasterly 356.5 feet to the Southeast corner of Kennedy's 2nd Addition to Biscay, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of the Register of Deeds, Beland County, Minnesota; thence northeasterly along the northeasterly line of said Kennedy's 2nd Addition to Biscay, 1254 feet to the northeasterly corner thereof; thence southwesterly 182.5 feet to the southwesterly corner of Block 7 of Kennedy's 1st Addition to Biscay, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of the Register of Deeds, Beland County, Minnesota; thence northwesterly along the North line of said lot 7, 192 feet to a point 33 feet East of the West line of the Northwest quarter of Section 25 in Township 116, Range 29; thence North to a point 33 feet East of the place of beginning; thence West to the place of beginning.

WHEREAS, it appears to the said Board of Commissioners that said petition is regular and valid on its face as required

by section 412.03 of Laws of Minnesota for 1945,

IT IS ORDERED, That the Board of Commissioners of Helred County, Minnesota, does hereby determine that said petition is regular and valid on its face, satisfying the requirements of section 412.03 of Laws of Minnesota for 1945.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That an election be held at *HASSAN VALLEY TWP. HALL - Buses*, situated

Jan within the above described territory on the *7th* day of *Jan*, 1947, between the hours of *9* o'clock A.M. and *8* o'clock P.M., at which time the residents of the above described territory may be allowed to vote on the proposition, accepting or rejecting the incorporation of the above described territory as a village, all pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 412 of Laws of Minnesota for 1945.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the Sheriff of Helred County, Minnesota, post copies of the petition herein and this order as a notice of election at three (3) public places within the above described boundaries, or as required by the provisions of Section 412.04 of Laws of Minnesota for 1945.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That Lloyd Hammerstrom
Mrs. William Vorlicek and Earl Barnes
all being residents of the above described territory be, and they hereby are, appointed as inspectors of said election pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 412 of Laws of Minnesota for 1945, who shall act as Judges of said election and conduct the same as far as practicable in accordance with the laws regulating the election of town officers, and who shall at once, following said election, make and file with the Auditor of Helred County,

Minnesota, a certificate of canvass of the ballots cast at said election.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Auditor of McLeod County, Minnesota, do, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to prepare a sufficient number of ballots to be used at said election all in the form prescribed by Section 412.05 of Laws of Minnesota for 1945.




