A Proclamation for Storm Relief

WHEREAS, a severe storm struck certain sections of Lyon, Murray and Pipestone Counties on June 9, 1947; and

WHEREAS, hundreds of homes were badly damaged and practically all barns and other farm buildings destroyed in the stricken areas; and

WHEREAS, the local supply of carpenters and masons is inadequate to meet this emergency condition which requires immediate rebuilding and repairs of housing and farm buildings; and

WHEREAS, there is a further critical shortage of building materials, such as sheetrock for repair of ruined plaster walls in water-damaged houses, roofing materials and other necessary items;

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, that LUTHER W. YOUNGBLAD, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby call upon our carpenters, masons and dealers in building materials in the State to come to the assistance of their fellow citizens in the stricken area so that they may be prepared for the coming of winter with adequate shelter for themselves and their livestock. Offers to give this aid and other inquiries should be directed to Mr. Carl R. Olson, State Relations Officer of the American Red Cross, State Capitol, St. Paul, Minnesota.
