

Ordinance No. 35.

Ordinance annexing additional territory to the incorporated limits of the Village of Browerville, Todd County, Minnesota, by virtue of proceedings under Section 707, Chapter 9, of the revised statutes of the State of Minnesota for the year 1905, and of the amendments thereto.

Section 1. Whereas on the 3rd day of May 1912, Julia Lisowski and Albert Lisowski who are the sole owners of said land herewith more particularly described, as follows to wit:-

Commencing at the north-east corner of the north-east quarter of the south-west quarter of Section Eight (8), Township One Hundred and Thirty North of Range Thirty-three (33) West, thence South on the forty acre line Three Hundred and Fifty-five (355) feet to a place of commencement, Thence running West eighty (80) rods, thence South along the section line Sixteen (16) rods, thence East Eighty (80) rods, thence North Sixteen ~~16~~ (16) rods to the place of commencement, and containing Eight acres, but excepting from this tract a Cartway Twenty-five (25) feet wide on the East side which the Grantor deeded to Julia Zigan. Said tract of land adjoining, and abutting upon the Village of Browerville. The said Julia Lisowski and Albert Lisowski have petitioned and described, asking that said property be annexed to and become a part of the incorporated limits of the Village of Browerville as aforesaid, and whereas ~~for that~~ said petition conforms to the requirements of Section 707, Chapter 9, of the revised statutes of the State of Minnesota for the year 1905, and of the amendments thereto.

That said land commencing at the North-east corner of the North-west quarter of the South-west quarter of section Eight (8), Township One Hundred and Thirty North of Range Thirty-three (33) west, thence South on the fortyacre line Three Hundred and Fifty-five (355) feet to a place of commencement. Thence running west eighty (80) rods, thence South along the section line Sixteen (16) rods, thence East Eighty (80) rods, thence North Sixteen (16) rods to the place of commencement, and containing Eight acres, but exception from this tract a Cartway Twenty-five (25) feet wide on the East side which the Grantor deeded to Julia Zigan. Said tract of land adjoining and abutting upon the Village of Browerville, Todd County, Minnesota. Be and the same is hereby annexed to incorporated into and made a part of the incorporated limits of said Village of Browerville as fully to all intents and purposes as though said above described property had been included within the original incorporated limits.

Ordinance annexing additional territory to the incorporated limits of the Village of Browerville, Todd County, Minnesota, by virtue of proceedings under Section 707, Chapter 9, of the revised statutes of the State of Minnesota for the year 1905, and of the amendments thereto.

Section 1. Whereas on the 7th day of May 1912, Rozalia Cech, who is the sole owner of seventy-five (75) feet off the North end of lot One (1) Block One (1) of Basset's Second Addition to the townsite of the Village of Browerville.
