Gentlemen:

Your petitioners respectfully represent and show to your honorable body:

I.

The undersigned, consisting of twenty-five or more of the voters who have resided within the territory hereinafter described continuously for a periof of at least two years prior to the date of this petition respectfully request of your honorable body to call an election for the determination of the incorporation of the present village of Urbank, which has a platted portion , and surrounding vicinity, the boundaries of said territory being as follows to-wit:
