We, the undersigned, being ten, or more, of the voters residing within the territory hereinafter described and proposed to be incorporated as a village, and situated in the Towns of Grant, Oneka and May, in said county and state, do hereby respectfully petition your Honorable Board, and allege:

1. That all of your petitioners are legal voters of and in the territory hereinafter described, and reside in said territory.
2. That the said territory for the incorporation of which as a village this petition is made, is contained within the following boundaries:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of the plat of Withrow, and thence proceeding along the South line of said plat of Withrow, a distance of Twelve Hundred Sixty (1260) feet to the Southeast corner of said plat of Withrow; thence Northerly at right angles to the South line of the tract herein described to the North line of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4}$  of  $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-one (31), Township Thirty-one (31), Range Twenty (20); thence Westerly along the North line of said Southwest Quarter of said Southwest Quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4}$  of  $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section Thirty-one (31) and continuing Westerly along the North line of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter ( $SE\frac{1}{4}$  of  $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-six (36), Township Thirty-one (31) North, Range Twenty-one (21) West, to a point Three Hundred Thirty-seven (337) feet West of the Northeast corner of said Southeast Quarter of said Southeast Quarter ( $SE\frac{1}{4}$  of  $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section Thirty-six (36); thence Southerly in a straight line to the Northerly right-of-way line of the Minneapolis, St. Paul, & Sault Ste. 3. That substantially all of said territory proposed to be incorporated as a village has been platted into lots and blocks, the plat of which has been duly and legally certified according to the laws of the State of Minnesota, and has been filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds for the County of Washington and State of

4. That the hereinbefore described territory contains a population of not less than fifty (50) inhabitants, nor more than fifty-three (53), and said Town of May is contiguous to the State line.

5. 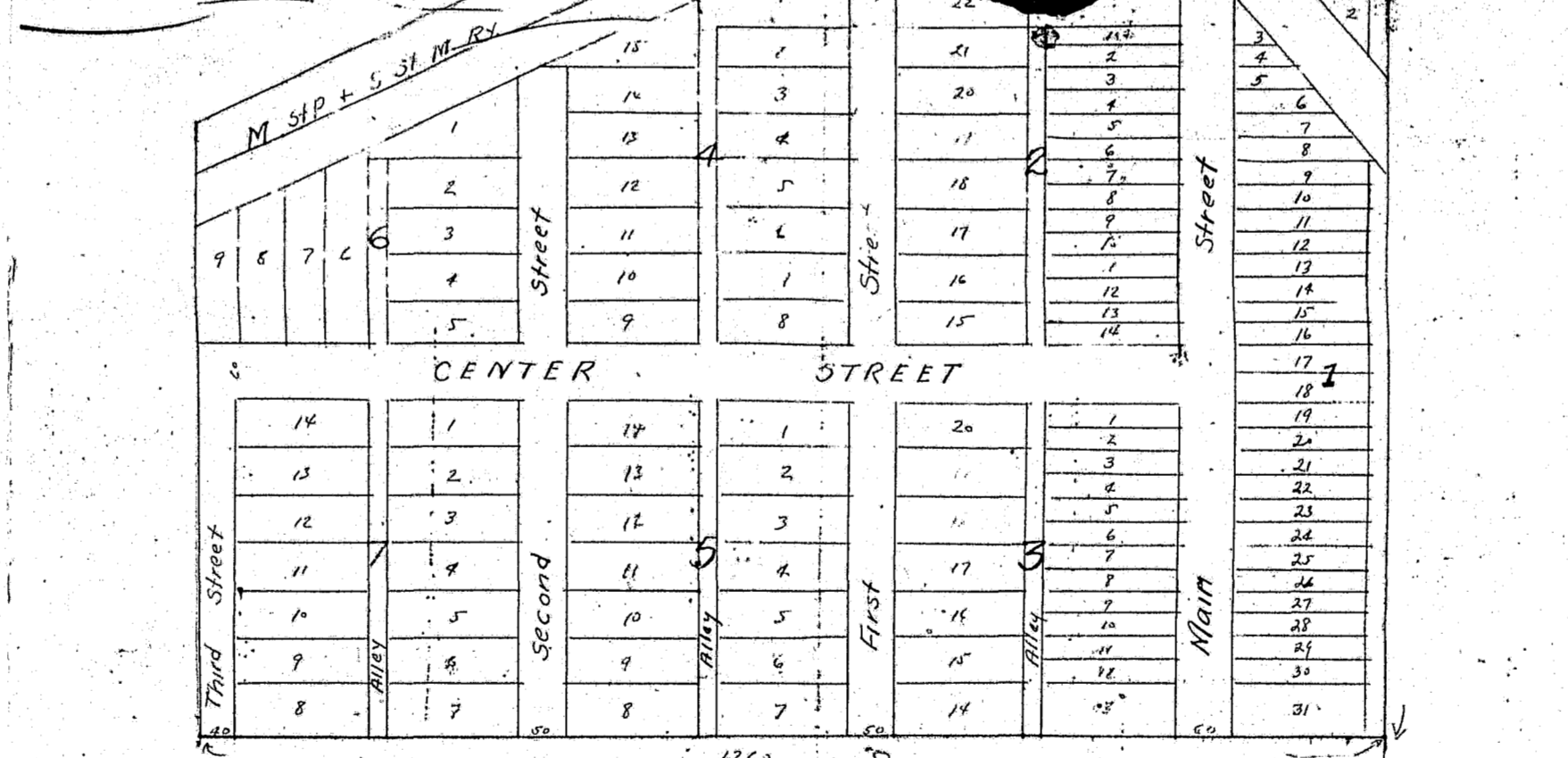
