EXECUTIVE ORDER

A Proclamation of Civil Air Patrol Week

- WHEREAS, the CIVIL AIR PATROL is taking an increasingly important position as an Auxiliary of the UNITED STATES AIR FORCE, training potential AIR FORCE Cadet Candidates in the fundamental principles of aviation; and
- WHEREAS, the War and Navy Departments have recognized the importance of this organization in creating and maintaining interest in aviation among the youth of America; and
- WHEREAS, the Minnesota Wing Commander, CIVIL AIR PATROL, has proclaimed the week September 27 through October 4, 1947 as CIVIL AIR PATROL week for the purpose of recruiting new
