PETITION TO ESTABLISH A CITY OF THE FOURTH CLASS
TO BE KNOWN AS THE CITY OF GAYLORD.

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, SIBLEY COUNTY, MINNESOTA:

The undersigned inhabitants of contiguous territory, not organized as a city, and having a population of not less than 1,000 inhabitants, who are duly qualified to vote within the territory herein designated as the territory proposed to be incorporated into a City of the Fourth Class, do hereby petition your honorable body to establish a City of the Fourth Class, and to call a special election to determine whether or not a City of the Fourth Class shall be established in the following described territory, all situate in the County of Sibley, State of Minnesota, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section Number Thirty-two (32), Township Number One Hundred Thirteen (113), North of Range Number Twenty-eight (28) West, Sibley County, Minnesota, thence North to the Northwest corner of Government Lot Number Three (3), Section 29, thence East to the meander line of Lake Titloe, thence in a Southeasterly direction following the meander line of said Lake Titloe to the Northeast corner of Government Lot Number Five (5), Section 28, thence South to the Southeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 33, thence in a Southwesterly direction along the North line of the Minneapolis and St. Louis Railway Company right-of-way to the East line of Section 32, thence South to the Southeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 32, thence West to the Northeast corner of the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 32, thence South to the Southeast corner of the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter, thence West to point of beginning.

That the following described territory shall constitute the First Ward of the proposed City of the Fourth Class:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section No. 32, Township No. 113, Range 28 West, thence North to the Northwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Sec. 32, thence East to the Southeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 33, thence in a Southwesterly direction along the North line of the Minneapolis and St. Louis Railway Co. right-of-way to the East line of Section 32, thence South to the Southeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 32, thence West to the Northeast corner of the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 32, thence South to the Southeast corner of the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 32, thence West to point of beginning.

That the following described territory shall constitute the Second Ward of the proposed City of the Fourth Class:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section No.32, Township No.113, Range 28 West, thence North to the Northwest corner of Government Lot Number Three(3) of Section 29, thence East to the meander line of Lake Titloe, thence in a Southeasterly direction following the meander line of said Lake Titloe to the Northeast corner of Government Lot Number Five (5) in Section 28, thence South to the Southeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 33, thence West to the place of beginning.

In support of said petition, your petitioner states and represents that there are 1260 inhabitants in said described territory and that 588 voters voted in said territory at the last general election for state officers, and that the residence of each signer on the petition is correctly stated opposite his signature.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray that a City of the Fourth Class, to be known as the City of Gaylord, be established in said described territory, and that a special election be called to determine whether or not such city shall be incorporated as the City of Gaylord, and that a resolution be adopted approving said petition and that the time and place of holding such special election be designated in said resolution and specify the location of the polling place of each ward, all as provided in Section 411.01, Subd. 1-6, Minnesota Statutes, 1945.
