

AN ACT OF THE LEGISLATURE

OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA

A Declaration of Opticist Week

WHEREAS, the Opticists Clubs of the State of Minnesota are celebrating the period from October 30th to 11th, 1947, as Opticist Week; and,

WHEREAS, the Opticists Clubs of the State of Minnesota are an organization functioning in the public interest, serving this state through their activities as "Friends of the Boy," thereby performing an important service in curbing juvenile delinquency; and,

WHEREAS, it is of public importance that such good works continue and expand and that all members of this state recognize the achievements of the Opticists Clubs of the State of Minnesota;

THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, do hereby resolve that the week beginning on October 30th, 1947, shall be designated as

"Opticist Week"

for the State of Minnesota, and that all citizens of this State shall be called upon in observance thereof.
