WHEREAS, The week of Saturday, October 25 to Saturday, November 1, inclusive is being celebrated throughout the United States as National Apple Week and designated as National Apple Day; and

WHEREFORE, I, Arthur C. Tamm, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of October 25 through November 1 as
