A PROCLAMATION OF MINNESOTA RADIO WEEK

WHEREAS, The radio has become an important factor in the lives of people; and,

WHEREAS, The radio stations of the State of Minnesota have contributed much to our education, entertainment and general welfare of the residents of this State, and have done a commendable job of service in the public interest; and,

WHEREAS, The radio industry gave a great impetus by its way of new inventions, improvements, and developments to further enlarge its contributions to the American way of life; and,

WHEREAS, The week of October 26 has been designated "National Radio Week";

I, ERNST W. JAHNKE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim that the week beginning on October 26th, 1947, shall be designated as

"Minnesota Radio Week"

for the State of Minnesota, and that all citizens of this State shall be called upon to observe thereto.

In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul this twenty-seventh day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred forty-seven and of the state one hundred eighth.
