

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE VILLAGE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF PRESTON,
FILLMORE COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Village of Preston, as follows:

SECTION 1. The village boundaries of the Village of Preston, Fillmore County, Minnesota, are hereby extended to include the following described real estate, viz:

All that portion of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section 5, township 102 north of range 10 west lying south of U. S. Highway Number 52, excepting therefrom a parcel described as beginning at the northwest corner of the northwest quarter of said section 5, thence east 526 feet, thence south 872 feet, thence westerly along the right-of-way of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad Company to the section line between sections 5 and 6 in said township and range, thence north 732 feet to place of beginning, and excepting therefrom a parcel described as all that portion of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of said section 5 lying south and east of the center of the main channel of the Root River, all of said lands being in Fillmore County, Minnesota.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after the filing with the secretary of state of a certified copy hereof..
