That the votes oest at and apeoiel election were duly cenvessed on Deoember 3, 2947, by the city council of the city of Bivabik. acting and sltting as the canvassing boaxd, and said Amendment of Section 7 (a) of seid Oity Oharter was ther cupon by said council declared duly ratifited and adopted by said vote, and the undersigned makes this certificete getting forth the Amendment of section 7 (a) of said Charter, and the ratification and adoption thereof, pursuant to and In conformity with the provisiong of gection 36, Artiole IV, of the Constitution of the state of Minnesott, and of gection 1285 of Mason's Minnesota statutes for 1937 and acts amendatory thereof.

Section 7. Tieative officers and Date of Election.
(a) The council shall be composed of a mayor, three councilmen and a clerk, who shell be qualified electors and all of whom shell have the right to vote at council meetings, and who shall be elected at large In the moaner hereinafter provided. The mayor shall preside at all council meetings at which he is present and shall have an equal vote With other members of the council on any mather coming before that body, and he shall have no veto power. The resident electors shall choose the following named officers; namely, a treasurer, an assessor, whose compensation shall not be greater than three hundred dollars (\$300.00) in any year and who shall be elected at the annual city election in 1948 and who shall be appointed by the ofty council until the first secular day of January, 1949, two constables, two justices of the peace, and a comoil composed of a mayor, a clerk and three councilmen. All offtueers upon their qualifications as such shall hold office until their successors qualify. Vacancies in office may be rilled, for the remainder of the term for which respective officers were elected, by the council; it the council because of equal division of votes is unable to fill the vacancy, then the mayor shall fill the vacancy by appointment for the unexpired term. All of ty elections for the terms and in the manner herein provided shall be held annually on the first tuesday after the first monday in December in each year at Which the above named officers shall be elected for the terms following, to mit: Mayor, for the term of two years; one councilman, for the term of three years; one clerks for the term of two years; and all other such officers, each having a term of two years. All terms, except as herein otherwise provided, shall commence on the first secular day of January following the election.
