

An Ordinance to extend the boundaries of the Village of Climax Polk County, State of Minnesota.

At the regular meeting of the Village Council of the Village of Climax, Polk County, State of Minnesota, held on the third day November, 1947. Councilman, Ed Will moved the adoption of the following ordinance which motion was seconded by C. L. Davidson.

The Village Council of the Village of Climax, do ordain as follows.

Sec one. Whereas a Petition duly signed by all of the owners of a parcel of Land, abutting the platted part of the Village of Climax Polk County, State of Minnesota, asking that the said Village of Climax extend the boundaries of the platted part, so as to have such parcel of land included within the platted part of said Village of Climax. after due consideration, the Village Council of the Village of Climax ordained as follows; to extend the boundaries of the said platted part of the Village of Climax, to have such parcel of Land included within the platted part of the said Village of Climax, and such parcel shall become a part of said Village of Climax, as effectually as if it had been originally a part thereof and described as follows;

That part of the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section twenty nine (29) township one hundred forty eight (148) north of range forty-eight (48), west of the 5th principal Meridian described as follows: Commencing at the southeast corner of Block three (3) of Bennett and Wisners Addition to Climax, running thence south and parallel to the section line between section twenty nine (29) and thirty (30) in said Township, a distance of two hundred sixty-one (261) feet; thence at right angles west a distance of one-hundred sixty (160) feet; thence at right angles north and parallel to said section line a distance of two hundred sixty-one (261) feet; to the south boundary line of said Bennett and Wisners Addition to Climax, being the south line of the alley of said addition; then at right angles east a distance of one hundred sixty (160) feet to the place of beginning.

Sec two. that this said parcel of land is now divided into four (4) equal size lots, as follows; seventy-five (75) feet wide, east and west, and one hundred thirty (130) feet long, north and south, and a ten (10) feet alley running north and south in center, and between the lots:

Section Three. (3) that hereafter this parcel of land shall be known as Strommen's Addition to Climax, Polk County, Minnesota, and beginning in northeast corner, numbering Lot one (1) Block one, and northwest corner as Lot two (2) Block one, and southwest corner as Lot three (3) Block one (1); and southeast corner as Lot four (4) Block one (1)

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and Publication

Upon the call of the ayes and nays the vote stood as follows. Councilman voting in the affirmative: C. L. Davidson, Ed Will, Palmer Brokke. Councilman voting in negative: None.

AN ORDINANCE

To Extend the Boundaries of the Village of Climax, Polk County, State of Minnesota.

At the regular meeting of the Village Council of the Village of Climax, Polk County, State of Minnesota, held on the third day November, 1947, Councilman Ed Will moved the adoption of the following ordinance, which motion was seconded by C. M. Davidson.

The Village Council of the Village of Climax, do ordain as follows:

SEC. ONE. Whereas a Petition duly signed by all of the owners of a parcel of Land, abutting the platted part of the Village of Climax, Polk County, State of Minnesota, asking that the said Village of Climax extend the boundaries of the platted part, so as to have such parcel of land included within the platted part of said Village of Climax, after due consideration, the Village Council of the Village of Climax ordained as follows: To extend the boundaries of the said platted part of the Village of Climax, to have such parcel of Land included within the platted part of the said Village of Climax, and such parcel shall become a part of said Village of Climax, as effectually as if it had been originally a part thereof and described as follows:

That part of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section Twenty nine (29), Township One Hundred Forty-eight (148) North of Range Forty-eight (48), West of the 5th Principal Meridian, described as follows: Commencing at the southeast corner of Block three (3) of Bennett and Wisner's Addition to Climax, running thence south and parallel to the section line between section twenty-nine (29) and thirty (30) in said Township, a distance of two hundred sixty-one (261) feet; thence at right angles west a distance of one hundred sixty (160) feet; thence at right angles north and parallel to said section line a distance of two hundred sixty-one (261) feet, to the south boundary line of said Bennett and Wisner's Addition to Climax, being the south line of the alley of said Addition; thence at right angles east a distance of one hundred sixty (160) feet to the place of beginning.

SEC. TWO. That this said parcel of land is now divided into four (4) equal size lots, as follows: seventy-five (75) feet wide, east and west, and one hundred thirty (130) feet long, north and south, and a ten (10) feet alley running north and south in center, and between the lots.

SECTION THREE (3). That hereafter this parcel of land shall be known as Strommen's Addition to Climax, Polk County, Minnesota, and beginning in northeast corner, numbered Lot one (1), Block one, and northwest corner as Lot two (2), Block one, and southwest corner as Lot three (3), Block one (1), and southeast corner as Lot four (4), Block one (1).

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
