## Resolution

hereas the village council of Cass ske, Cass County, since one, then being a duly incorporated village under the laws of vince one and having a population of more trantwo thousand inhabitants did, by resolution duly passed and a groved by its council and filed with the secretary of State of since one, establish a sunicipal Court in and for said village on June 4th., 1912, under the seviced Laws of 1905 which court has ever since functioned and now is functioning thereunder in suitable warters provided for holding assions of said court and the records thereof in the sunicipally owned village hall in said village;

and thereas the village council of said village of Casa Lake, now making a population in excess of one thousand insabitants and in which village so municipal court existed prior to the taking effect of said hevised laws of 1905 and prior to the establishment of the present municipal Court as aforesaid, desire to adopt the provisions of Chapter 482 of minnesota Statutes, 1945, for the future government of said municipal Court, under the provisions of section 483.04 thereof and to that and for that pur-

pose be it,

Resolved by the village council of Cass Lake, minnesota, that said municipal Court so established and now functioning in said village shall be known as "the municipal Court of the Village of Cass Lake" under the provisions of Chapter 435 of minnesota statutes 1541 for its future government; that messions of said court shall be held in the municipal court rooms in the village hall, a municipally owned building in said village; that there shall be two judges to preside over said court, one to be known as functipal Judge and one as special municipal Judge; the municipal Judge shall receive a per diem salary payable monthly by the council, prorated per diem on the southly salary provided for the municipal Judge, for acting during the absence or disability of the municipal Judge, only, and paid by the council from the salary of the funicipal Judge, that said court shall have one clark who shall be appointed by the junicipal Judge revided that the salary of such clark shall be paid by the said judges and out of their salaries.
