A Proclamation of "School Safety Patrol Week"

WHEREAS, the members of the School Safety Patrols, through their faithful performance of duty and exemplary conduct, provide an outstanding illustration of good citizenship and valuable community leadership; and

WHEREAS, the various civic organizations which sponsor and give encouragement to the activities of the School Safety Patrols are to be commended for this important public service;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDALE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week, beginning February 22, 1948, as

"SCHOOL SAFETY PATROL WEEK"

and call upon all community organizations and citizens to give their cooperation and assistance to the advancement of the School Safety Patrol Program in Minnesota.
