PETITION FOR INCORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLERNIE

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Washington, Minnesota:

The undersigned Twenty-five (25) voters, residents of the territory hereinafter described hereby petition your honorable board to fix a time and place when and where the resident voters may vote on the proposition of incorporating such territory as a village, to be known by the name of Willernie.
