

RESOLUTION

A Proclamation of "Seeds to Europe Week"

- WHEREAS, a national program has been organized to enable residents of this country to send garden seeds to people of Europe, where not only food for this winter, but seeds for next spring's vegetables are reported to be scarce because of crop failures; and
- WHEREAS, under this program an effort will be made to facilitate gifts of garden seeds by individuals to their friends and relatives abroad; and
- WHEREAS, the Church World Service, Inc., a non-profit organization, or any recognized charitable organization of the donor's own choice, will deliver these packages to needy families abroad where the donor does not wish to name any particular recipient; and
- WHEREAS, all formalities of shipment will be handled by seed stores, working in cooperation with the American Seed Trade Association, and special prices, including delivery, substantially lower than the cost of the same quantity of seeds at current retail values in this country, will be made on these packaged shipments;

BEFORE ME, JAMES H. HENNING, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week beginning February 2 as

"Seeds to Europe Week"

and urge all citizens of Minnesota to contribute to this humanitarian assistance to the people of Europe.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul this thirty-first day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight and of the State the nineteenth.
