"Birthday Speeches to the National Order of Eagles"

WHEREAS, the National Order of Eagles was formed in Seattle, Washington, February 6, 1918, just fifty years ago; and

WHEREAS, the National Order of Eagles has for many years sponsored a constant immigration program which has resulted in legislation bringing many thousands of immigrants to this country; and

WHEREAS, the National Order of Eagles is vitally interested in the welfare of juvenile delinquency in our state, and has established anti-drug clubs; and
