LEGISLATIVE MESSAGE

A Presentation of the Boy Scouts of America

WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of America constitute an organization dedicated to community service, leadership, good health, fair play, brotherhood and patriotism; and

WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of America organization has touched the lives of more than fourteen million boys and men and now includes more than two million Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Senior Scouts and adult leaders who are united in working for good citizenship; and

WHEREAS, February 8 marks the thirty-ninth anniversary of the founding of the Boy Scouts of America; and

WHEREAS, the theme which the Boy Scouts will emphasize throughout the year is "The Scout Oath at Work...in his home...in his community...in his nation...in his world; and

WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts, in working with this theme, will stress conservation of food and natural resources, the planting of gardens, safety and fire prevention, home building and personal health studies;

BEFORE ME, CHARLES E. JOHNSON, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby prescribe February 6 to 12 as

"BOY SCOUT WEEK"

and will urge all citizens to honor and assist the Boy Scouts and their adult leaders in carrying on a program which enriched the state through the building of character in our youth and in the performance of the highest community service.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul this second day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight and of the state the ninetieth.
