PROCLAMATION

A Proclamation of National Security Week

WHEREAS, for the past twenty-five years the Honorable Officers Association of this state has observed the period of February 12 through 22, inclusive, as National Security Week, in which virtually every civic and patriotic group in the state has joined;

AND WHEREAS, in current unrest and uncertainty which grips the world, posing a constant potential threat to our nation and our traditions of freedom and justice, grave responsibilities upon our nation's leaders; and

AND WHEREAS, the needs for preserving our national strength, which must be recognized by all of our people, bring responsibilities not only of great import to every state and every community but also to every individual citizen;

BEFORE ME, HERBERT F. WILSON, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period of February 12 through 22 as

"National Security Week"

During which it is urged that the official flag of the United States be displayed on all official buildings and at other appropriate places on state property, and that the many business, civic, and patriotic organizations demonstrate by their action their support of the WPA and National Security Week, and that every citizen give his utmost cooperation to the observance of this period, which is of such vital importance to all of us.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul this eleventh day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight and of the state the ninetieth.
