A Proclamation of "Student Nurse Enrollment Week"

WHEREAS, nursing is a noble profession which offers to young women great opportunities for service to humanity and promising careers for individual advancement and recognition; and

WHEREAS, increasing numbers of student nurses are needed immediately to provide graduate nurses for jobs of responsibility in our hospitals, clinics and other health facilities; and

WHEREAS, the growing public interest in health care demands for hospital care are bringing a steady expansion of hospitals and other health facilities which indicate the need for nurses will become even greater in years to come; and

IT IS IMPORTANT THAT INFORMATION ON THE OPPORTUNITIES, ADVANTAGES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR NURSING EDUCATION AND A NURSING CAREER BE BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF YOUNG WOMEN OF OUR STATE SO THAT THEY MAY PROPERLY WEIGH THE FUTURE OF THE NURSING PROFESSION AGAINST THAT OFFERED BY OTHER PROFESSIONS; AND

WHEREAS, the efforts of the Minnesota Nurses Association, the Minnesota Medical Association, and the Minnesota Hospital Association, aided by other public-spirited organizations, to interest young women in nursing as a profession deserve the whole-hearted cooperation of the entire State;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDAHL, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim April 16 through April 21, 1948, as

"Student Nurse Enrollment Week"

and call upon the young women of our State to observe this week by considering the many opportunities afforded by careers in nursing.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul this thirtieth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred forty-eight and of the state the ninetieth.
