

In the matter of the Incorporation of
the Village of South International Falls.

WHEREAS, there was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Koochiching and State of Minnesota, a petition of this the following is a copy:-

"We, the undersigned, voters residing within the territory herein described, situated in said County, which real estate has been partially platted into lots and blocks and is adjacent to real estate which has been so platted and which plat and plats thereof have been duly and legally certified according to the laws of the State of Minnesota and duly filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said County, hereby petition your Honorable Body to appoint a time and place when and where the electors actually residing on said lands may vote for or against the incorporation of said lands as a Village under the laws of the State of Minnesota. The boundaries of said lands and territory are described as follows:--

Commencing at the Northwest Corner of Section Three (3) Township Seventy⁽¹⁰⁾ N. of Range Twenty-four (24) W., running thence South on the section line to the quarter section post in sections Nine (9) and Ten (10), thence East on the quarter section line to the center of section Eleven (11) thence North on the quarter section line to the North line of Section Two (2) in said Township, thence West on said section line to place of beginning, containing Fourteen Hundred, Forty-one and 15/100 (1441.15) acres, according to the United States Government Survey thereof. Said ^{being}lands/also described as the West Half (W.1/2) of Section Two (2), the North Half (N.1/2) of Section Ten (10), the Northwest Quarter (N.W.1/4) of Section Eleven (11) and all of

Section Three (3) in Township Seventy (70) N. of Range
Twenty-four W. according to the United States Government
Survey thereof.

That a census of the resident population of said terri-
tory was caused to be taken by your petitioners on the 28th.
day of June, 1912. That the number of actual residents
thereon at the time of the taking of said census was 306.
That the name proposed for said Village by your petitioners
is, South International Falls.
