

CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTORS

We, the undersigned Inspectors (appointed by the County Board and acting as Judges) of a Special Election held April 13, 1948, between 9:00 a. m. and 5:00 p. m. at the Rose Town Hall located on Mainline Ave. and County Road "B" on the "Proposed Incorporation of the Village of Roseville" hereby certify as follows:

(1) That a map was prominently displayed during the Election showing the boundaries of the affected territory, which was Carpenter, Mainline and Rockland Avenues on the south, the West County limits on the west, County Road "B" on the north, and Rice St. on the east.



P E T I T I O N

TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF RAMSEY COUNTY, MINNESOTA:

The undersigned hereby proposes the incorporation as a village of the following described property, located in the County of Ramsey, State of Minnesota:

Commencing at the centerline of Larpenteur Avenue and Rice Street, thence West along the centerline of Larpenteur Avenue to the centerline of Hamline Avenue; thence North along the centerline of Hamline Avenue to the centerline of Roselawn Avenue; thence West along the centerline of Roselawn Avenue to the West line of Ramsey County; thence North along the West line of Ramsey County to the centerline of County Road "B", being the North line of Rose Township; thence East along the North line of Rose Township to the centerline of Rice Street; thence South along the centerline of Rice Street to centerline of Larpenteur Avenue, and there terminating, said lands being within the red lines of the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.

The undersigned respectfully represent that they are voters who have resided continuously within said area for more than two years immediately prior to the date of this petition; that the area of said described lands is approximately Eight Thousand Eight Hundred (8,800) acres; that contained within said described lands are Seventy (70) plats which have been duly and legally certified and filed in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Ramsey County, Minnesota. That the platted property contains approximately Two Thousand Fifty-Two (2,052) acres, and consists of the following plats: Woodlynn Park, Plainview Heights, A. K. Farnum's Garden Lots, Lake Owasso Villa, Lake Owasso Park, Minnesota Realty Co's Owasso, St. Paul Park, Reiling Park, St. Paul Park, Mackney Park, Ashback Park, Lake Johanna Homes, Rohleder's Oak Grove, Rolling Acres, Twin View, Hanson Hills, Todds Out Lots, Rolstad's Addition, Westmoor Addition, Garvik's Homesites, Woshrie's Addition, Weinholzer's Addition, Chas. A. B. Weide's Midway Addition, Cope's Subdivision of Lot 1, Cope's Subdivision of Southeast One Quarter, Koalska Addition, C. W. Michael's First Addition, C. W. Michael's Second Addition, Lee Addition, Hamm Heeli Addition, Hamm's Re-arrangement, Auditor's Subdivision No. 46, Rice Street Grand View Addition, Joy's Rice Street Addition, Michel's Re-arrangement of Lots 9 to 16, Swartz Subdivision, Lakecrest Addition, Thorntons Subdivision of Northeast One-Quarter, Aug. Giesmann's Subdivision, Shady Beach, Holling Green, Montgomery's Lake View Addition, Sarah's, Ryan Heights, Asylum Outlots, Frankson's Garden

Plateau, Leier Park, Auditor's Subdivision No. 85, Jordan's Garden Lots, Arthur E. Thom Plat, Rosacrest Villas, Keller's Mayflower Park, Midway Hills Re-arrangement of Como Garden Lots, Fernwood, Rose Town Gardens, Pothen's Addition, Lexington Heights, Diedrich's Homesites, Schacht Addition, Idawill Homesites, Snelling View Homesites, Beverly Addition, Ridgewood, Mid Oaks, Sunset View, Bonrman's Five Acre Lots, Fairways Subdivision, Carcelon Addition, and Lauderdale's East Side Addition; and that the unplatted area is adjacent to said plats.

The undersigned further represent that said platted areas are largely used for residential purposes; that a large portion of the unplatted area is divided into small miscellaneous descriptions and has been so conveyed and is being used for residential purposes; that the southerly line of said area is either adjacent to or within a short distance from the limits of the City of Saint Paul, and that the west line of said area is adjacent to the limits of the City of Minneapolis; that said above described area has been largely built up for residential purposes as a suburban area to said cities and the remaining area is rapidly being platted, divided and used for residential purposes; and that said entire area is used so as to be properly subjected to village government.

Your petitioners further represent that a census of said area was accurately taken commencing with the 23rd day of February, 1948, and ending with the 27th day of February, 1948, and that the number of actual residents upon said above described area is 4589, and that the proposed name of the village is "Roseville".

WHEREFORE, YOUR PETITIONERS REQUEST The Board of County Commissioners of Ramsey County to call an election for the determination of the proposed incorporation of said village as provided by law.
