A Proclamation of the Centennial Anniversary  
of Minnesota

WHEREAS, on March 3, 1849, the Congress of the United States passed  
the Organic Act establishing the Territory of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, this historic event in 1849 marks the beginning of Minnesota  
government and acknowledges the existence of the Territory by  
country, community, organized pioneer who devoted their  
ambition, talents and faith in the united effort to build that  
early Minnesota into the great state in which we live today;

WHEREAS, the one-hundredth anniversary of the beginning of Minnesota  
is truly an occasion worthy of solemn reflection and festive  
observance by all citizens; and

WHEREAS, this glorious milestone in the life of our State should serve  
as a heart-felt inspiration and trustworthy guide for the future  
on the basis of a treasury of satisfactory records and review  
the achievement of the distinguished men and women who helped  
foster the human, spiritual and material progress of the  
Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, the State Legislature has wisely set aside the year 1948 as a  
time for the celebration of the Centennial of Minnesota and  
has entrusted the Minnesota Historical Society with the responsi-  
bility of formulating plans for a proper state-wide commemorative  
program.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, I, LUTHER W. VANDERKAM, Governor of the State of Minnesota  
do hereby proclaim the year 1948 as a time for the observance of the

Centennial Anniversary of Minnesota

so that in my patriotic devotion to the ideals and historic past of  
the men and women who have contributed to the progress of the State during  
the past one hundred years, I call upon all citizens and organizations  
to cooperate with the Minnesota Historical Society in the observance of  
this significant occasion and further call upon the heads of all political  
subdivisions of the State to form a similar organization according  
this intent.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have  
hereunto set my hand and  
sealed the Great Seal of  
the State of Minnesota to  
be affixed at the State  
Capitol in St. Paul this  
thirtieth day of April  
in the year of our Lord  
one thousand nine hundred  
forty-eight and of the  
State the ninetieth.
