A Proclamation of "National and Inter-National Music Week"

WHEREAS, Minnesota is a state of true music lovers and is proud of its many fine orchestras, choruses, bands and artists of national and world reputation;

Now, therefore, I, LUTHER W. YANGDAHL, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week beginning May 2 as

"NATIONAL AND INTER-NATIONAL MUSIC WEEK"

and urge all citizens to observe this week by furthering our outstanding achievements in music culture and in encouraging more people to take advantage of the enjoyment which music brings.
