A Proclamation of "Naval Reserve Week"

WHEREAS, the Civilian Naval Reserve is dedicated to the building of better citizens and the protection of this nation's costly investment in world peace; and

WHEREAS, a strong peacetime Naval Reserve is vital if America is to do its full part in maintaining the peace; and

WHEREAS, the Civilian Naval Reserve offers training and educational opportunities to our young people; and

WHEREAS, the Navy and Naval Reserve are endeavoring to enroll into the Reserve sufficient young people to secure these important aims;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDAHL, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 9 to May 15 as

"NAVAL RESERVE WEEK"

and call upon the citizens of this state to lend their full interest and support to insure the success of the Naval Reserve program.
