A Declaration concerning Health Care

WHEREAS, health is a basic necessity for the happiness and protective living of all citizens and must be carefully planned and preserved; and

WHEREAS, the hospitals of Minnesota have long taken active leadership in preparing health and better living for the people of our state through sound procedures to give medical care to the sick and injured, through education of public, nursing and medical personnel, research in the interests of health care, and through the engagement of all community health aides and

WHEREAS, only by the understanding and full cooperation of everyone in the community is it possible for our hospitals to continue to improve standards of care and to progress in providing this vital service for all;

WHEREAS, I, DALE H. WISEHOLLER, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby call upon all citizens of Minnesota to join with the men of the Nation on May 12 in observing

Health Care Day

In appreciation of the dedicated services which our hospitals and their employees daily give in safeguarding the public health.

IN FAITHFUL MEMORY, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul this first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred forty-eight and of the state the ninetieth.
