A Declaration of National Hospital Day

WHEREAS, health is a prime necessity for the happiness and productive living of all citizens and must be carefully guarded and conserved; and

WHEREAS, the hospitals of Minnesota have long taken active leadership in promoting health and better living for the people of our state through constant promptness to give careful care to the sick and injured, through education of medical, nursing and technical personnel, research in the sciences of health care, and through the improvement of all community health conditions; and

WHEREAS, only by the understanding and full cooperation of everyone in the community is it possible for our hospitals to continue to improve standards of care and to progress in providing this vital service for all;

THE GOVERNOR, I, **MARK H. HOLM**, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby call upon all citizens of Minnesota to join with the rest of the Nation on May 12 in observing

NATIONAL HOSPITAL DAY

in appreciation of the essential services which our hospitals and their employees daily give in safeguarding the public health.
