

WICHITA, on January 11, 1922, a Wichita man was sent by the Council of the League of Nations who had been present here and invited as a speaker for the purpose of giving his first time declaration originally made on November 1, 1917 by the members of the Wichita League and caused by the said person in behalf of the establishment in Wichita of a national home for the disabled persons.

and documentation. People should receive training through self-study, and educators shall be responsible for linking the existing cultural, political, economic, creative and spiritual conditions as will ensure the development of the spiritual dimension.

On September 2d, 1847, the General Assembly of the United States at their session at Great Falls, in the Territory, constituted and organized a new county under its jurisdiction, and gave unto said county boundaries and determined that henceforth French and Arapahoe shall be set up and established out of Nebraska's territory and constitute the boundaries of said county, as follows:

Mr. Boland has explained the situation as he sees it over there, offering his \$5,000, and the Dublin Society for Education which was constituted by the people of Ireland under Astorino Dow and all of the people here and the establishment of the Dublin National Fund has guaranteed that no remark would emanate by the State or Foreign Partition Congress which would give vent to any idea of independence of these United Provinces.

Gov. MURRAY, I. WILLIS W. BREWER, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, proclaiming behalf of the people of the state of Minnesota and bearing due regard for the recognition given by the League of Nations and President Wilson "to the historical connection of the Jewish people with Palestine and to the demands for reconstituting their national home in that country" and recognizing the long-established position of the United States of America favorably "the establishment of Palestine as a national home for the Jewish people" as expressed in a joint resolution of Congress of June 30, 1922, do hereby designate Sunday, May 30, 1936, as "Jewish Palestine State Day", and upon behalf of the great state of Minnesota, do hereby herald the birth of the new Jewish State in the old Holy Land and bestow upon it the new status of dominion in the area east of the Jordan and also for Israel, liberty and the spirit of independence and peace throughout the land of Palestine and to all the Jewish people.

In writing further, I have
reported that my health has
