

Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Section 110, Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, do hereby constitute and appoint G. L. Ware of Hopkins, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General in the Department of the Attorney General, for the period commencing June 1, 1948, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. I hereby fix his compensation at the sum of \$5000 per year.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand at St. Paul, Minnesota, this 1st day of June, 1948.




