- E $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, Township 46, Range 30
- W $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, Township 46, Range 30

Said appointee is to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law.
