An Ordinance annexing certain Unplatted Lands to the
Village of Kandiyohi, Minnesota.

The Village Council of the Village of Kandiyohi do
ordain as follows:

Section 1-

That the following described Unplatted Lands, to-wit:

That part of the North West Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the North
East Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Ten (10), in Township One Hundred
Nineteen (119) North, of Range Thirty-four (34) West, of the
Fifth Principal Meridian, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the center of the North East Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
of Section Ten (10), aforesaid Township and Range, thence running
West along the line between the South West and North West Quarters
of said North East Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Ten (10), a
distance of 1,116.5 feet, thence North 150 feet, thence East
parallel and 150 feet distant from the line between the North West
and South West Quarters of the North East Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of
aforesaid Section Ten (10) a distance of 1,116.5 feet, thence
South 150 feet to the point of beginning and containing 3.83 acres,
said tract now being Lot One (1) of the North East Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
of Section Ten (10), Township One Hundred Nineteen (119) North,
Range Thirty-four (34) West;

which lands are situate in the County of Kandiyohi and State of
Minnesota, adjacent to and abutting upon the Incorporated Village
of Kandiyohi, in said County and State, and containing less than
and not exceeding Two Hundred (200) Acres, be, and the same hereby
are, annexed to the said Village as effectually as if they had
been originally a part thereof, and the boundaries of said Village
are hereby extended so as to include the above-described lands.

Section 2-

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from
and after its publication and the filing of a certified copy thereof
with the Secretary of State.

ORDINANCE NO. 15
