A Proclamation of National Guard Day

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has declared September 16, 1948, as National Guard Day to honor those who have served and those who are now serving their country in the National Guard, and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota National Guard has served the State and Nation faithfully in war and in peace and

WHEREAS, the National Guard will always be the bulwark of our peace and security;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDALE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, in order that we may acknowledge the service performed by our citizen soldiers, do proclaim Thursday, September 16, 1948, as

"NATIONAL GUARD DAY"

in Minnesota and I urge all of the citizens of this great State to support the growth of the Minnesota National Guard in every way possible.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul this third day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight and of the State, the ninety-first.
