A Proclamation of Truck Courtesy and Safety Week

WHEREAS, The Minnesota Motor Transport Association has been conducting a very commendable courtesy and safety campaign among its members during the past two years; and

WHEREAS, the organization has further given valuable leadership to a broad safety program for all operators of commercial vehicles in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, the Association will hold its annual Minnesota Truck Rodeo on September 18th and 19th at the State Fair Grounds in order to give added emphasis to the importance of safe driving and courtesy by the operators of commercial vehicles; and

WHEREAS, these activities are helping to encourage safety on the public roads of our state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDAHL, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 13th to 20th as

"TRUCK COURTESY AND SAFETY WEEK"

and urge that all commercial vehicle drivers and other citizens who operate automobiles observe and practice the safe driving techniques that will be demonstrated at the Truck Rodeo.
