A Proclamation of National Youth Month

- WHEREAS, there are many children in the state and nation who need additional help and guidance so that they may develop strong character and sound bodies and minds; and
- WHEREAS, the need for educational opportunity, recreation, proper medical care, physical development and good family life for all youth must be given the full attention of all adults and youth organizations; and
- WHEREAS, the month of September has been designated as National Youth Month; and to further emphasize the importance of wholesome youth activities and guidance; and
- WHEREAS, the business houses of America, the press, the radio industry and many other organizations have joined their cooperation in presenting appropriate programs and activities for National Youth Month; now

WHEREAS, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGDAHL, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of September as

NATIONAL YOUTH MONTH

and call upon all citizens to join in the observance of this special month in a fitting salute to the youth of our state and nation.
