A Proclamation honoring the memory of General Von Steuben

WHEREAS, the 17th day of September was the birthday of General Friedrich Von Steuben; and

WHEREAS, General Von Steuben contributed greatly to the laying of the foundations of our nation by his loyal services as Inspector General of the American Army under George Washington during the Revolutionary war; and

WHEREAS, the memory of his part in the winning of the war calls attention to the fact that people of all nations sacrificed to establish the United States of America as a free nation;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUCILLE K. YOUNGDAHL, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim that the 17th day of September, 1948, shall be an occasion on which the people of Minnesota are invited to honor the memory of General Friedrich Von Steuben.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul this tenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred forty-eight and of the State the ninety-first.
