Eighteenth Annual Religious Education Week Proclamation

WHEREAS, our nation can successfully meet the moral challenges of these crucial days only if there are spiritual resources upon which our people can draw for courage and inner strength; and

WHEREAS, our religious faith has, through the ages, proven to be the sole source of the necessary spiritual resources; and

WHEREAS, it is essential, therefore, that we place increasing emphasis on the values of religious education for our children and ourselves;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGBLAD, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period beginning Sunday, September 26, and continuing through Sunday, October 3, 1948, as the

"EIGHTEENTH ANNUAL RELIGIOUS EDUCATION WEEK"

Let these be days when in our churches and schools of religion we reinform our individual minds and renew our spirits at the fountain-head of all wisdom and inspiration, namely, the Eternal God. So shall our life together in family, community, state and nation be strengthened and made more adequate to the demands of these times.
