


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Section 114 of Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, and upon the request of the Commissioner of Highways, do hereby constitute and appoint John Malcolm Sharp, of White Bear Lake, Minnesota, Special Assistant Attorney General and fix his compensation in the sum of \$3,720 per annum to be paid from and out of the Trunk Highway Fund. Said Special Assistant Attorney General shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. Said appointment shall take effect on the 15th day of September, 1948.




