A Proclamation in Behalf of the Parent-Teacher Enrollment

WHEREAS, our public schools stand at the forefront of American institutions which require the continuous interest, understanding and active support of all citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Parent-Teacher Associations have for more than twenty-five years provided the means in Minnesota whereby all citizens could join together in studying the problems of our schools and working for better educational opportunities for all children; and

WHEREAS, there are now more than 100,000 members of Parent-Teacher Associations in Minnesota engaged in helping to meet community responsibilities toward our children; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Congress of Parents and Teachers has designated October as a special period of time for the enrolling of new members into this worthy organization;

I, THOMPSON, E. LUTHER G. YOUNGDAHL, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 1949, as

PARENT-TEACHER ENROLLMENT MONTH IN MINNESOTA

and urge all citizens to consider the many benefits of Parent-Teacher Associations and to assist in these activities for the welfare of our children and the future of our state and nation.
