




KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of authority vested in me by statute, and at the written request of the Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota, do hereby constitute and appoint Frederick P. Bradford as Special Assistant Attorney General to act in condemnation proceedings brought on behalf of the Board of Regents and to render other legal assistance to said board, effective September 22, 1948, and to serve thereafter at the pleasure of the Attorney General, or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law; and I hereby fix the compensation of said Frederick P. Bradford, as such Special Assistant Attorney General, at the rate of \$250 per month, to be paid by the Board of Regents.


