A Proclamation for National Parental Week

WHEREAS, the delinquency of youth is invariably but the reflection of his adult surroundings; and

WHEREAS, it is clearly evident that parents have the most vital responsibility in providing proper examples, training and environment for their children; and

WHEREAS, the United States Junior Chamber of Commerce has designated a special week for a nation-wide program calling attention to the importance of strengthening the home and parental influence over youth; and

WHEREAS, this is a worthy effort designed to help find the causes of juvenile delinquency and to develop a program of prevention actions;

LET, THEREFORE, I, LUTHER W. YOUNGBLOOD, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, do hereby proclaim the week of September 26 to October 2, 1948, as

NATIONAL PARENTAL WEEK

and urge all citizens to join in this worthy effort to better help youth through better parental guidance.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in Saint Paul this twenty-second day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight and of the State, the ninety-first.
