ORDINANCE # 72
AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE BOUNDARIES
OF THE VILLAGE OF NORWOOD, CARVER COUNTY
MINNESOTA.

The Village Council of the Village of Norwood do ordain
as follows:

Whereas, the owners of the following described tracts or
parcels of land situate, lying and being in Carver County, Minn.,
