- WHEREAS, the people of Europe are in desperate need of food and clothing as they strive to recover from the effects of the recent war; and
- WHEREAS, the Cooperative for American Donations to Europe, known as C.A.D.E., is a non-profit, government-approved organization composed of our nation's trusty-citizen leading relief agencies; and
- WHEREAS, C.A.D.E. provides Americans with an opportunity to make a personal gift of food and clothing to friends and relatives abroad, with delivery guaranteed; and
- WHEREAS, the C.A.D.E. Committees of Minneapolis and St. Paul are jointly sponsoring C.A.D.E. WEEK as a means of calling public attention to the value of this help to the war-torn people of Europe;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ARTHUR W. JOHNSON, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 26 through October 31 as

CAD E WEEK

and urge all citizens to give support to this humanitarian effort which is truly an investment in peace and an outstanding expression of international brotherhood.
