KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of authority vested in me by statute, and at the written request of the Minnesota State Agricultural Society of Minnesota, do hereby constitute and appoint Wm. C. Green of St. Paul, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General to give legal advice to said society and to act in litigation if brought on its behalf in the matter of a construction contract and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. The compensation of said Wm. C. Green as such Special Assistant Attorney General shall be paid by the Minnesota State Agricultural Society and shall not exceed \$500 unless circumstances require a modification of such amount by the Attorney General.
