NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the 26th day of November, 1948, between the hours of 7:00 A.M., and 8:00 P.M., be and is hereby fixed as the time, and that the Robert B. Dyar residence located on the right side of the road after entering the Maplewoods Gate on the West shore of Weeooky Pond, within the territory described in said petition as the place where an election shall be held to determine whether or not the territory described in said petition shall be incorporated as the Village of Maplewoods.

PETITION FOR ELECTION

To the Honorable County Board
of the County of Hennepin;

Your petitioners respectfully represent;

I.

That all of the territory hereinafter described is situated in the County of Hennepin, State of Minnesota, and is not in any incorporated village; that said territory has all been platted into lots and blocks by various plats which have been duly and legally certified according to the laws of this state and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of said county excepting small portions of said territory unplatted which are adjacent to said platted land, which unplatted part of the territory is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

II.

That the territory above referred to is described as follows:

Government Lot 1, and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18; and all of Section 7, all in Township 117, Range 22; Government Lots 1 and 2, Section 12, Township 117, Range 23, and Government Lot 1, Section 13, Township 117, Range 23, according to U. S. Government survey.

That the boundaries of said territory are described as follows;

Commencing at the intersection of the east shore of Robinson's Bay of Lake Minnetonka with the south line of Government Lot 1, Section 18, Township 117, Range 22; thence east along the south line of said Government Lot 1 and the south line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and along the south line of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 18 to the east line of Section 18; thence north along the east line of said Section 18 to the northeast corner of said section, and continuing north along the east line of Section 7, Township 117, Range 22 to the shore of Lake Minnetonka; thence westerly, northerly and

southerly along the shore of Lake Minnetonka to the point of beginning.

III.

That the major portion of the said territory has been platted and known as Maplewood for more than thirty years and that the residents of said territory during all of said time have had a community of interest and have been organized and represented by a non-profit association formerly unincorporated but now a corporation known as Maplewoods Improvement Association, Inc.

IV.

That said territory contains a resident population of not more than 10,000 nor less than 100; that your petitioners have caused a census of the resident population of said territory to be taken, a copy of which census is hereto attached showing a population of 382, and that said census was taken within eight weeks prior to the date of this petition.

V.

That petitioners are voters who have resided within the said territory continuously for a period of at least two years prior to the date hereof.

VI.

That your petitioners desire that said territory be incorporated as a village under the laws of the State of Minnesota and that the name of said village be the Village of Maplewoods.

WHEREFORE your petitioners pray that your Honorable County Board call an election within said territory for the determination of the proposed incorporation thereof as a village to be known as Maplewoods.
